### INDUSTRY WATCH

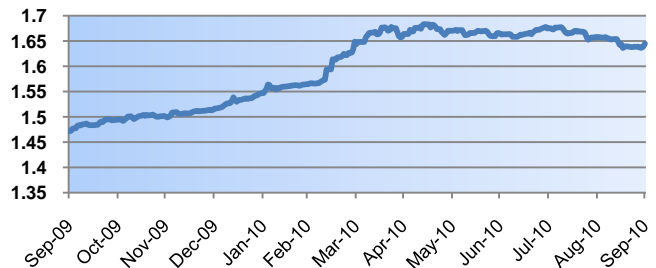
In the quarter under review, the National Pension Commission ("PenCom"), in its bid to institute a dynamic investment regulatory framework for pension fund assets, has carried out a revision of the Regulation on Investment of Pension Fund Assets (Regulation). The draft exposure was released to the public and all concerned for their review and comments. Some additional investment alternatives: Real Estate Investments Trust (REITS), Supranational Bonds issued by Multilateral Development Finance Organizations and Specialist Investment Funds such as Infrastructure Funds and Private Equity (PE) Funds and Global Depository Receipts/Notes (GDRs/Ns) issued by Nigerian companies for their operations within Nigeria.



### The Stanbic IBTC RSA Fund

The Stanbic IBTC RSA Fund ("The Fund") which opened on 02 May 2006 at N1.0000 closed at N1.6452 as at 30 September 2010. In line with investment guidelines issued by PenCom, the Fund's portfolio allocation was as follows on 30 September 2010: Government Securities (45.84%), Money Market (20.60%), Quoted Equities (21.44%), and Other Fixed Income (12.12%).
